2019 KATHY NORMAN MEMORIAL JUNIOR HORSE SHOW

The Junior Horse Show will be Saturday, April 13th at 10:00 am at the McDowell Saddle Club Show Grounds on Highway 226 South off I-40. Rain Date: April 14th at 1:00 pm

The show is sponsored by the McDowell Agricultural Youth Foundation, United Fund, Farm Bureau-McDowell, and McDowell County businesses.

All classes will have cash premiums as listed in the information packet. Premiums will be mailed to the address on the entry forms. Winnings not claimed within 30 days of awarding will be forfeited.

Enclosed are the rules, list of classes, and premiums. Pre-registration is required and due by March 22nd. All entries must be complete and entered on an official form. You may make additional copies as needed. There will be an entry fee of \$5 per class. Exact change would be appreciated. Make checks payable to: McDowell Agricultural Youth Foundation. No entries past March 25th.

We hope the information provided in this packet will help you prepare for this year's show. If you have any questions, or need to check on the show status in case of inclement weather, feel free to call the Cooperative Extension Office at 652-8104. Hope to see you at the show!





GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

- 1. Youth between the ages of 5-19 on January 1st are eligible to show in the horse classes. The Lead Line class is open only to youth 6 and under.
- 2. <u>Pre-registration is required and due by March 22nd</u>. There is no limit to the number of entries an exhibitor may show.
- 3. Premium money will be presented for placing in classes as listed and will be mailed to the exhibitors at the address listed on the entry form.
- 4. Rosettes will be awarded on show day. The Premier Exhibitor trophy and prize money will be awarded at the Awards Banquet in August.
- 5. A trophy will be given to the youth who accumulates the most points in each age division: 5-8 yrs old

9-13 yrs old

14-19 yrs old

6. The Premier Exhibitor award is presented to the youth who accumulates the greatest number of points. Classes less than 3 exhibitors will not count towards Premier Exhibitor. Points will be awarded as follows:

- 7. In case of a tie, the winner will be the Exhibitor receiving the highest placing in the Showmanship and Equitation classes. If no Showmanship or Equitation points are awarded, the Exhibitor with the greatest number of first place honors will be named Premier Exhibitor.
- 8. Entry Fees There will be a \$5 entry fee per class for all participants. These fees will be paid on show day. NO ENTRIES AFTER March 25!
- 9. Classes of 12 or more may be split at the judge/superintendent discretion.
- 10. Horse registration papers are **not** required.
- 11. All animals must be healthy and are subject to be inspected. You must present an <u>original</u> negative. North Carolina Coggins Test certificate for each horse <u>before unloading your</u> <u>horse from the trailer</u>. The test must have been administered no more that 12 months prior to the date of the show.
- 12. Parents or other adults will not be allowed to assist exhibitors in the show ring except in the

Lead Line and Special Needs class. Special Needs Class participation will require a handler in the show ring. Parents are encouraged to assist exhibitors in getting their entries to the show ring so that classes may begin on time.

- 13. Spectators and exhibitors assume all liabilities for themselves, their stock, and belongings.
- 14. Unruly and unmanageable horses will be excused from the show ring at the judge's discretion.
- 15. Class age breaks will be based on the exhibitor's age as follows:

Youth

5-8 on January 1

Junior

9-13 on January 1

Senior

14-19 on January 1

- 16. ALL Pets at the showground must be on a leash. No Exceptions.
- 17. Saddle Club Showground will be open at 8:00 am.
- 18. Exhibitors are responsible for all their own equipment.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their horses, which includes all hay, straw bedding, feed, and manure. **Failure to do so will result in forfeit of premium and awards.**
- 20. Horses must be able to perform the required gaits for the classes entered.
- 21. No stallions will be allowed in the show or on the show grounds.
- 22. For further information or determination of rain date status contact the Cooperative Extension Office at 652-8104.
- 23. The show will begin **promptly at 10:00am.** Please be on time and ready to enter the show ring when classes are called.
- 24. Exhibitor may only show one animal in Showmanship Class.
- 25. Appropriate tack and attire for your discipline is highly recommended, but will not be judged over clean, neat attire and tack in good working condition. Suggested minimum standard for attire is long sleeve shirt, neat jeans, slacks or jodhpurs. Boots with functional heel are required, no bare feet, sandals or sneakers. ASTM approved safety helmets are REQUIRED at all times while mounted. It is parents' responsibility to insure proper fitting. Showmanship and Equitation classes will have a stronger emphasis placed on the exhibitor's preparation concerning tack and attire. Clean, neat, well groomed appearance of exhibitor and animal are of utmost importance in these classes.
