Graduating senior, or in the Early College program, or currently enrolled at McDowell Technical Community College, and accepted by the college of their choice.

Plans to major in horticulture, agriculture, or a closely related field. Some examples include botany, biology, conservation, environmental studies, forestry, landscape architecture, crop sciences, local foods, animal studies and husbandry, golf course operation and management, etc.

Scholarship is awarded based on scholastic achievement, student application and personal statement, and recommendation from one teacher, counselor or other non-family member. Student should explain why they deserve the scholarship, their educational goals, and what they plan to do with the degree. Financial need is considered but not required.
